

Chart of difference between Recruitment and Selection

Points of differences	Recruitment	Selection
Meaning	Recruitment refers to the process of searching for appropriate candidates to fill the vacancies.	Selection refers to choosing the right candidate, who is most suitable for a job position that is vacant in an organization.
Objectives	Recruitment motivates the number of candidates to apply for a particular job.	Rejection of other candidates who are not suitable for that particular job.
Economy	Recruitment is not an expensive process.	It is very expensive.
Approach	It is a positive approach.	It is a negative approach.
Problems	In recruitment, there is no hurdle for the candidates to apply for the job.	candidates have reached at their job place by passing the hurdles
Priority	Recruitment is the first step.	Selection is the final process. after selection the candidate will be the employee of the organization.
Come and bye	In recruitment, candidates are welcome by saying "Yes".	This process tells bye to those who are not suitable for the job.
Sequence	Recruitment takes place before Selection.	It takes place after Recruitment.
